



Harden Moor (Open Country)

One of a series of easily accessible countryside sites within the Bradford Metropolitan District.

228 acres (85 hectares) of heather moor and woodland.

An ideal 'Walking for Health' site.

Due to the very nature of the countryside some paths may not be suitable for the less mobile and pushchairs. Wheelchair users may be restricted to the bridleway. Access to Harden Moor is via gates and stiles.

Around Harden Moor there are several disused quarries and large outcrops of rocks. Please take great care when walking near these features. No climbing or playing nearby.

Children should be under close supervision at all times.
