# Ilkley Moor - Open Country

One of a series of easily accessible countryside sites within the Bradford Metropolitan District.

1,855 acres (751 hectares) of heather, rough grass and bracken on a mainly north facing sloping site, 1/2 mile from Ilkley Town Centre.

Ideal 'Walking for Health' site

Due to the very nature of the countryside many paths are not suitable for the less mobile and pushchairs. Wheelchair users may find they are restricted to the hard surfaced paths and tracks around the Cow & Calf Rocks, White Wells Bath House and the Lower Tarn.

Across the Moor there are several disused quarries and many outcrops of rocks, along with streams of both natural and man made water features. Please take great care when walking nearby. Children should be under close supervision at all times.

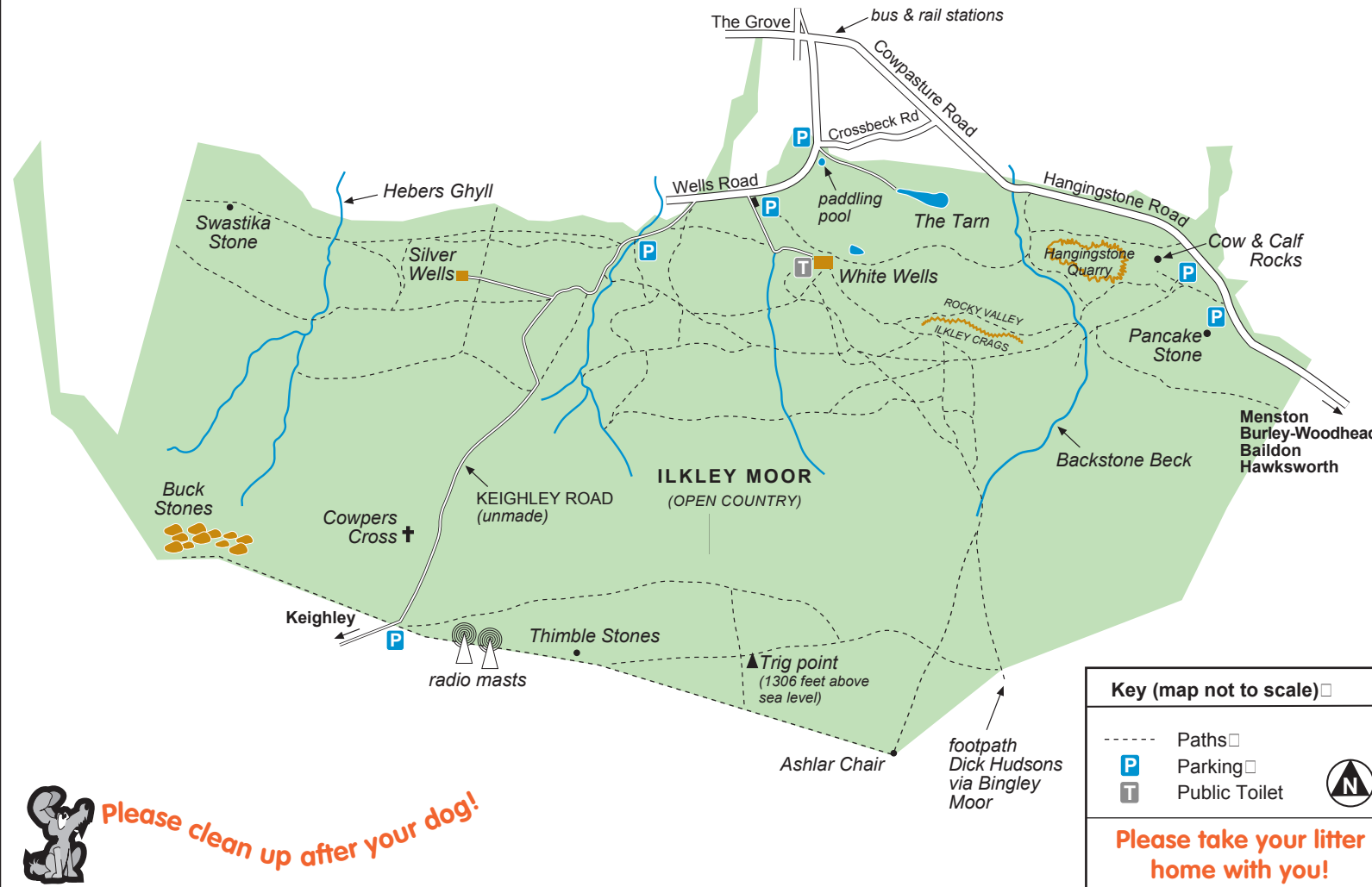
