

## **Manywells Landfill Remediation Update: July 2009**

### **Planning Application**

The planning application for the construction of the access road, re-profiling the site and filling the hollows in the fields was submitted to the Planning Division on 12 March 2009.

Public consultation drop-in sessions were held on 07/04/09 and 18/04/09 with a total of 42 members of the community called in to review the information and discuss it with the project team.

Environmental Protection Division provided a response as a consultee to the planning process. In order to demonstrate transparency, the response was 'peer reviewed' by a land quality specialist officer from another local authority. The planning application reference number is 09/01181/FUL.

It is anticipated that the result of the planning decision will be known by September.

### **Community Working Group**

The last meeting of the MCWG was held on 26/02/09 and was attended by community representatives who discussed the planning application proposals. Next MCWG meeting to be held when the result of the planning decision is known in September 2009

### **Newsletter**

As there is little to report about works at the site, the issue of the next newsletter is now deferred from the end of July until September when the outcome of the planning decision should be known.

### **Current activities at the site**

The monitoring and maintenance of environmental controls at the site continues. The new temporary gas flare is fully operational and is burning all the time. This should control odour from the site.

No complaints have been reported to Environmental Protection officers.
