### Existing School Layout



Please note that structural surveys and ground investigation surveys will be carried out at the school and/or other sites that are being proposed in the options below. These surveys will be carried out in the two week Easter holidays and non intrusive surveys being carried out at other times. Findings from these surveys will further inform our option appraisal.

## **OPTION 1**

Option 1 proposes to refurbish and remodel the main bulk of the school, leaving untouched block 4 and the sport hall both of which are recent addition to school and as such does not require any amendments



### **Advantages**

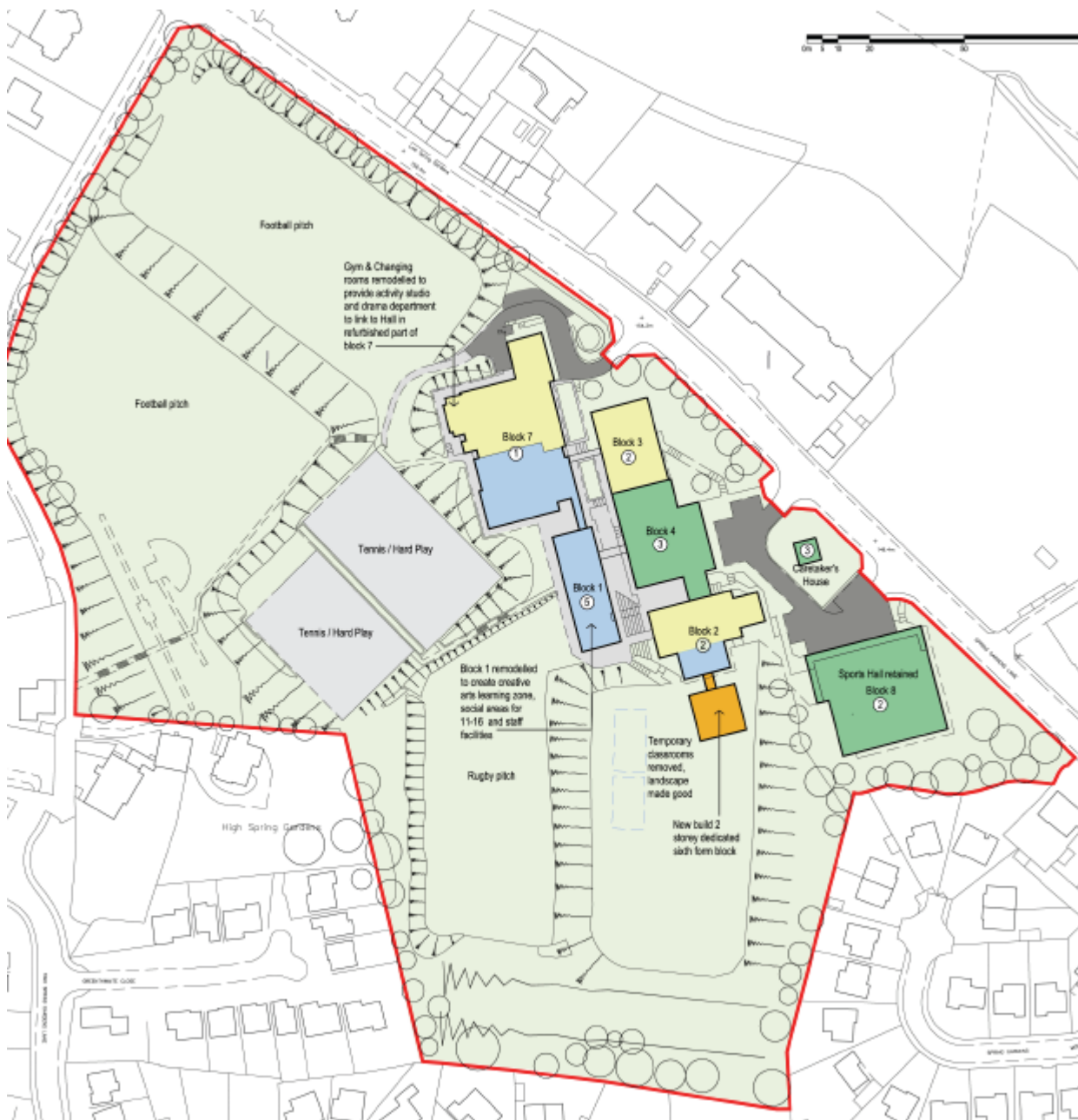
- No major issues from a planning perspective
- No implications from a Sport England perspective
- Careful phasing of the construction phase will minimize any decanting requirements

### **Disadvantages**

- Refurbishment and remodel of existing accommodations may limit educational transformation.
- A thorough grounds survey of the area is required to ensure the viability of this option.

## **OPTION 1b**

Option 1b proposes to refurbish and remodel the main bulk of the school, building a new extension next to Block 2 (in orange) and leaving untouched block 4 and the sport hall both of which are recent addition to school and as such does not require any amendments



### **Advantages**

- No major issues from a planning perspective
- No implications from a Sport England perspective
- Careful phasing of the construction phase will minimize any decanting requirements

### **Disadvantages**

- Refurbishment and remodel of existing accommodations may limit educational transformation.
- A thorough grounds survey of the area is required to ensure the viability of this option.

## OPTION 2

This proposal aims to demolish Block 1 (“the tower”) and replace it with a new build. The remaining of the accommodations would be refurbished or retained as is in the same line than Option 1.



### Advantages

- Removal of the worst building on the campus and replacement with a new build should support the school's aspiration to transform education
- No major issues from a planning perspective
- No implications from a Sport England perspective
- Careful phasing of the construction phase will minimize any decanting requirements

### Disadvantages

- A thorough grounds survey of the area is required to ensure the viability of this option.

### OPTION 3

Replacement of the school's accommodations with an entire new build. Whilst an architect's option, neither the Local Authority nor the Catholic Diocese of Leeds are considering an entire new school on this site.



#### Advantages

- New facilities will support the implementation of the school's Education vision and transformation.
- Careful phasing of the construction phase will minimize any decanting requirements

#### Disadvantages

- Sport England will object to this option on the basis that proposal will encroach on the external sport facilities
- A thorough grounds survey of the area is required to ensure the viability of this option.
