



Getting help



If you want care and support you will need to be assessed. This is now a self directed assessment and is centred around the person and their individual needs....

Who is eligible for help? At present Bradford has agreed that it can meet the needs of people which are critical, substantial or moderate, but not those which are low.

What next? When you first apply (or your care is reviewed) you will be sent an assessment questionnaire that you can discuss with friends or relatives.

Once the assessment has been completed an indicative budget will be allocated so that

you know approximately how much you have to spend on your care.

Once you know how much you have to spend you can work on your support plan which will show how you intend to spend your money to achieve the care and personal goals identified in your assessment.

We will keep checking on how you are doing to ensure you are meeting your needs and are safe and happy.
