

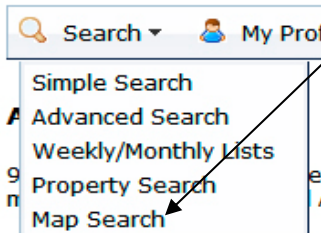
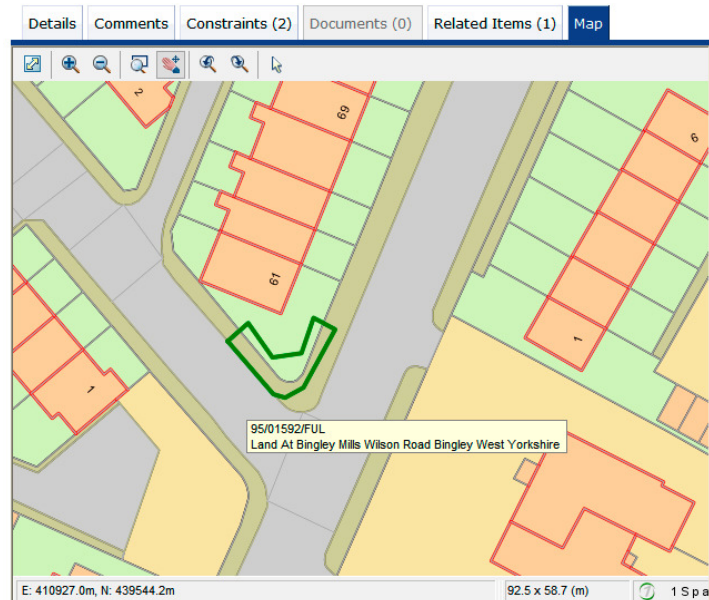
## Where is the application site?

Every application is plotted on a map. In public access, the application site is outlined in green, and you can see this site by clicking on the 'Map' tab of the application's details.

This outline is simply to denote the parcel of land involved, and does not imply ownership.

Any disputes about ownership need to be referred to the Land Registry.

Zoom and pan tools are available to move around the map.



There is also a map search function that allows you to search for planning applications by zooming in on a specific area. You can click on an application number to see its details.
