The benefits of this new forest are numerous, as well as being aesthetically pleasing it will create new wildlife habitats, help reduce carbon emissions and is especially beneficial for children's hands on outdoor education. Beech - tall gracefully smooth gold in autumn bronzed in winter

Rowan - medium height smooth skin with a network of scaly ridges in old age

Hazel - Festive, cultivated, small tasty, practical. Springs back after being knocked down.

Holly - Small dark prickly. Tempting in winter. Evergreen.

Birch - Medium height. Silvery white and slim. Warty patches.

Ash - Distinctive provider, reaches great height, Forward pointed teeth and hairs on the underside
