

Emergency Care Childminding Network

This service aims to offer care to young people aged 11-16 in crisis situations. These young people could be in a dispute with their parents or carers that can't be resolved the same day. They could be young runaways who have returned, or been picked up by the police, and need a safe place to stay while social workers investigate a return home.

The first 24-48 hours following a crisis situation is crucial for planning the young person's immediate future, Crisis Care Childminding placements will offer young people care during this time.

Training and support will be given to interested childminders.
