### What is Engaging Places?

Engaging Places is a resource to support teaching and learning through buildings and places.

Engaging Places is an initiative supported by the Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment (CABE) and English Heritage.

The Engaging Places website is built using the Culture24 publishing system and is powered by their database of UK cultural organisations, events, resources and exhibitions. Culture24 are non-profit online cultural publishers who are funded by MLA, Arts Council and DCSF.

- Provide a curriculum-focused resource for teachers in England to support, develop and enhance built environment education in primary and secondary schools.
- Inspire and guide teachers in accessing and using high-quality and relevant built environment education organisations and resources locally and nationally.
