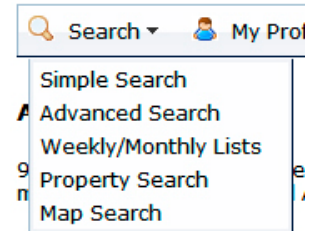


How do I search for multiple applications?

If you are interested in more than one planning application, you could use the 'Advanced Search' feature. You can access the advanced search by clicking on the 'Search' icon on the toolbar at the top of the page.



Advanced searching allows you to look for applications based on a range of criteria. For example, you might be interested in all planning applications in a particular ward, or applications granted between two dates.

In this example, the searcher is interested in 'FUL' applications granted in the City ward between 01/06/2009 and 31/12/2009

Dates

Enter a date range (a start date and an end date) for the criteria that you are interested in. The date fields may be entered manually using the date format dd/mm/yyyy (e.g. 21/06/2008). Alternatively, click on the calendar button and pick a date.

Use the drop down lists to select your criteria, and if appropriate enter dates in the dates section. You must use the full year in your date eg '2009', not '09'.

You will be given results in a list, from which you will be able to access application details by clicking on the blue text.

Registered users have the opportunity to save this type of search, and receive email updates when new results are added.
