The Waste Management DPD is a key document within Bradford's LDF which will bring about a change in the way the Council and its stakeholders deal with waste, both within the District and beyond until 2026.

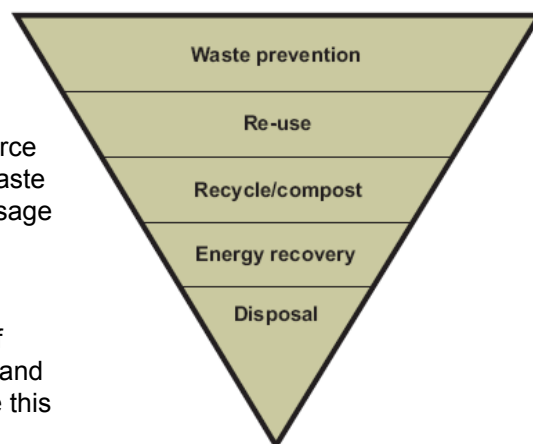
This plan will ensure that the District has sufficient and appropriate waste infrastructure to deliver the Council's aspirations for self-sufficiency. This includes:

- The identification of sites to accommodate waste management facilities
- Criteria based policies for the management of waste streams
- Policies for the management of waste in developments throughout the District; and
- A framework for the effective delivery and monitoring of those policies.

The future of Bradford's Waste

The District needs to take **responsibility** for the waste that is generated within its boundary and undertake a change in the way it **manages** this waste through more **sustainable waste management** methods.

This will involve moving the management of waste up the waste hierarchy i.e. reduction, re-use, recycling as well as composting; using waste as a source of energy and only disposing of waste as a last resort. The Council envisage being **self-sufficient** in managing waste that the District generates through locating waste facilities as close as possible to its place of production. The necessary plans and systems will put in place to enable this to happen.
