

Do you catch your bus on Channing Way or at Centenary Square in Bradford City Centre?

From **Sunday 25 July 2010** bus services will use new stops on **Broadway, Bridge Street, Hall Ings and Nelson Street.**

The bus stop changes are for the next phase of work towards creating Bradford's City Park. The work will see the temporary closure of Norfolk Gardens and the permanent closure of Channing Way to all traffic.

Only bus services affected by the closure of Channing Way are shown in this leaflet.

If you do not get on or off the bus at either Channing Way or Centenary Square, or if your bus service is not mentioned at all, **you are not affected** by these changes. However if you know someone who is affected by these changes, please pass this leaflet on to them.

Alighting only services towards **Interchange** using Channing Way stop **T12**

Services **570**, **571**, **576**, **615** and **616** which use the above stop will now after serving bus stops on Little Horton Lane **operate direct to the Interchange**.

Service **662** which also uses the above stop will now after serving the bus stop on Godwin Street will now also **call at Sunbridge Road stop S6** before the **Interchange**.
