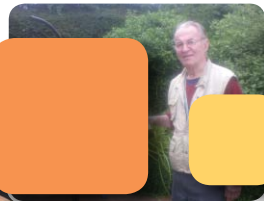


Personal Budgets



Personal budgets are part of the 'personalisation' of adult social care and are the key to unlocking choice and control over the services you receive....

What is a personal budget?

A personal budget is an upfront allocation of the amount of money the council gives you to spend on your social care - you may need to make a contribution to this based on savings and benefits.

Once you have an agreed support plan your personal budget will be finalised and there are then a number of options available on how you can manage it.

1. you (or a responsible person) can manage the money as a direct payment
2. you can ask the council to manage the money on your behalf
3. you can choose a combination of the two

If you choose to manage it yourself we can provide advice and support on how to do this.
