Residential and Nursing care homes



Residential or nursing care homes may be the right option for some people. If someone can no longer be supported:

- · in their own home
- · in supported housing
- · in extra care housing
- or if they require 24-hour care then it might be the best option for them.



Residential care home

Residential care homes provide care for people who need help with daily activities. This might be:

- washing
- dressing
- eating
- and help with day to day activities.



Nursing care home

Nursing homes are for people who have general care needs and also need care from qualified nurses.

This can include those with specific or complex health needs.

How do I find the right residential or nursing home?



There are many different homes across the Bradford District.

The Bradford Care and Support Directory has information about the homes across the District.



There is information about where homes are located, contact details, and how much they cost.

There is also a helpful checklist of questions to ask if you are visiting a residential or nursing home.

How do I apply for a place in a care home?



Moving into a residential or nursing care home is normally done by working with a social worker from Bradford Council.

How much you pay is decided by how much you can afford to pay. A check is completed to make sure you get all the benefits that you should be getting.
