Thank you for your request for consultation in relation to the Local Plan for Bradford District, which covers the 4 subjects listed below.

I have read through the documents for each of the subjects, there are no overall issues in relation to the Waste Management Plan, Shipley and Canal Road Plan and the Community Infrastructure Plan.

Having read through the proposals for the City Centre, a few of the residential developments I was aware of, however there is quite an extensive list of future apartment builds and the concern is that with the number of apartments being built and the increase of residents living within the City Centre, this could have a significant impact on Policing resources.

I understand the importance of redeveloping the City Centre, in that each new building can bring 106 financial contributions which help generate the rest of the area and I appreciate that when the apartments are developed, the Council have no say or influence over who live reside there.


In the past there were many high rise apartment blocks located in the City Centre that housed 'problem residents' which caused an increase in crime, where they became areas for anti-social behaviour, the concern is that we don't want problems of the past to reoccur.

If Police can continue to be consulted on each new residential build, we can continue to provide the advice and recommendations in respect of security measures to each development, which may reduce the risk of crime.
