

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Addingham Neighbourhood area

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday, 28 November 2019 to decide on the question below:

“Do you want City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Addingham to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3rd Floor, City Hall, Bradford, West Yorkshire, BD1 1HY by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 12 November 2019. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3rd Floor, City Hall, Bradford, West Yorkshire, BD1 1HY by 5pm on Wednesday, 13 November 2019.
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3rd Floor, City Hall, Bradford, West Yorkshire, BD1 1HY by 5pm on Wednesday, 20 November 2019.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 3rd Floor, City Hall, Bradford, West Yorkshire, BD1 1HY by 5pm on Thursday, 28 November 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 20 November 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 20 November 2019.
