QUESTIONS FOR THE PARISH COUNCILS 18/9/2020

Further to my previous question regarding policy SWES4 Protecting Non-Designated Heritage Assets the parishes supplied further evidence to justify the list of assets quoted in the policy. This is largely acceptable and can be included as part of the Plan. However, it has prompted the following further questions:

There are some minor omissions from the further evidence. The following assets referred to in the policy list are not referred to in the further evidence. This should be remedied if these are to be included in the policy list. They are:

SWES4/17 1,3,5,18a and 18c North Street.

I take this opportunity to bring to your attention that there are also the following extra assets referred to in the further evidence which are not included in the policy list. These cannot be included in the policy as they were not part of the regulation 16 stage of public participation. These are:

Silsden

58 - 61 St John's Street,

Old Cinema,

The School on Elliott Street,

Hothfield Street School,

Wesley Place - the original Methodist Chapel.

In the further evidence it is necessary to provide a little more elaboration as to why the following items are in the list:

Silsden Methodist Church

The Library - building now converted to houses.
