## The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (A650 Hard Ings Road Improvement, Keighley) (Side Roads) Order 2017

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under Section 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 -

- 1. authorising the Council to :-
- (a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering),
- (b) stop up private means of access to premises
- (c) provide new means of access to said premises

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified route known as the A650 Hard Ings Road, Keighley which the Council are proposing to improve from its junction with the A629 Beechcliffe Roundabout, generally eastwards to a point 75 metres west of its junction with the Bradford Road Roundabout.
