Looking south across The Site, from the existing dry-stone wall on the northern boundary of The Site. The dry-stone wall along the northern extraction boundary would screen the views of The Site, leaving only long-distance views of the valley. The dry-stone wall seen in this photomontage would be along the northern edge of the extraction and would be approximatly 1.5m. This photomontage is during the working of Phase 6, however, the view of The Site from this location would be very similar to this throughout the lifetime of The Site. The Working Phasing Plan (ref: 232/5 - 3) and the Restoration Phasing Plan (ref: 232/5 - 10) are included in this application.

These worst case scenarios are temporary and would quickly evolve as working and restoration progresses.
