The Trust support the Policy on pedestrian and cycle movements especially in relation to the Airedale Greenway which includes the Leeds & Liverpool Canal towpath. The Airedale Greenway is identified as a strategic cycle

and walking route on the policies map and the Policy requires that all development proposals adjacent to, or impacting on, key strategic routes will be expected to aid in the delivery of and contribute to an appropriate and proportionate level of public realm improvements to these routes.
