> Dear Sir/Madam
> I write regarding the plans to build 800 houses in Ilkley and further houses in the Wharfedale Valley.
> I am concerned that the already overcrowded roads and rail links to Bradford and Leeds will be unable to cope with the needs of extra commuters.
> Our Secondary School is struggling to cope with the number of pupils wishing to be allocated a place there - where are these extra children to be accommodated? Will it mean that children from outside Ilkley will have to go to schools beyond their catchment area leading to more traffic on the already busy A65.
There will also be a strain on already busy Health and Dental resources.
Green belt land will be lost for future generations.
My impression is that as usual money is the guiding principle- build the houses, get money from the developer under a 106 Agreement, do nothing about infrastructure, and leave the local population to deal with the resulting problems.
