waste management sites within the District will give regard to cross boundary issues, including waste movement and location of facilities in adjacent areas.

The nearest waste management site to Menston is on the border of Menston and Otley at Ellar Ghyll and so is within the Leeds District Council boundary. This site was originally formed with an incinerator that was scheduled to provide heating for the adjacent former Menston Children's Hospital (now housing and within the Bradford MDC boundary). The nearest Household Waste Recycling Site site to Menston within Bradford MDC is in Ilkley some 5 miles away.

Although a tacit agreement (the implementation of which is informal and erupts from time to time) is in place allowing Menston residents to use the site it is limited to cars and excludes trailers and trade waste. This exclusion has inevitably led to fly tipping on minor roads and verges within the village.
