This sentence both opens up the possibility of development in the Green Belt and suggests that its necessity is not yet established. The suggestion of the possibility of Green Belt development will recommend to house builders that planning applications will be entertained and therefore makes their refusal harder to justify and the success on appeal likely. Indeed, the fact that the Plan has made the suggestion of Green Belt development a possibility will push pressure onto this land for priority development. If this land is needed, demonstrate it to be so; if not, do not suggest it.

This indicates that the proposal to build in the Green Belt, particularly in Holmewood where there is extraordinary pressure for development created by the Council's plans, are

- not positively prepared as they do not meet objectively assessed requirements, according to the is sentence
- not justified as they are unproven in an evidence base

I find the evidence base for housing demand is proven, but not proven for risk to the Green Belt.
