#### New policy proposition

The importance of the Wharfedale railway line is paramount to likely and becomes even more important in the next period where the A65 to Leeds is under increasing pressure from new residential developments already designated in the Leeds Local Plan. Travellers from further out of Leeds are more likely to use the train and passenger numbers will increase.

I propose a new policy that the Wharfedale railway line needs to be specifically protected from any building development activity which might compromise the track stability.

There is a serious 'ring slip' to the East of Ben Rhydding which has been very expensively engineered in recent years to reduce the landslip affecting the railway, which for 20 years or more had a severe speed limit, only recently relaxed. Maintenance and continued adjustment work continue intermittently, because the slope remains volatile. The hillside above and below the line is subject to springs, steep watercourses and unstable slopes. Any activity other than grazing and forestry should only be carried out with approval from acknowledged technical experts.

Any building work in this area which might affect natural drainage should be avoided, because the impacts of the ring slip are not fully understood.
