The future vision for like is flawed in that it foresees changes to infrastructure which are not achievable by Bradford Council. There is no point in having a vision which cannot be delivered.

For example, before a new secondary school for the area is designed and planned, the school catchment area needs to be defined precisely, so that the number of children to attend can be estimated with confidence. But Ilkley Grammar School is no longer in Bradford's control as an academy and can in future set its own admission criteria (though it doesn't choose to do so yet except at 16+)

Further, public transport provision improvements are not in Bradford Council's hands. Where state subsidy has been reduced, so have bus services. Stating in the core strategy vision that it is planned to enhance bus services from Wharfedale to Airedale and Bradford is a hollow intention that will come to nothing if such services are not commercially viable.

With regard to trains, although West Yorkshire Railplan 7 indicates long term growth of passenger numbers, there appears to be no plan to deal with the bottlenecks – the single track sections on both the Leeds and Bradford lines from Ilkley or any signalling improvements that will increase capacity. With the opening of the new station at Kirkstall (at which Wharfedale line services are not programmed to stop), there will be even more pressure to give higher priority to trains on the Airedale line. This may lead to lengthening journey times and lack of confidence in rail connections from the Wharfedale line at Leeds.
