On behalf of the Woodland Trust, I would like to strongly support Policy ENV5 on trees and woodland.

The policy in particular gives strong protection to ancient woodland and ancient and veteran trees, which is highly appropriate as these habitats are irreplaceable. There is also a commitment to seeking opportunities for planting of new trees and woods and this is much needed given that in the supporting text it is acknowledged that woodland cover in Bradford is less than half the national average: 5% in Bradford, compared to 10% in England and 13% in the UK as a whole.

We welcome the strong emphasis on including trees and woods as part of a well planned and integrated network of green infrastructure, together with other types of greenspace. There is reference in the supporting text to use of access standards to determine where new GI may be needed and this is something we very much support. The Woodland Trust has developed an Access to Woodland Standard which is referred to in paragraph 5.4.21 of the supporting text and we would be happy to work with the Council to see how this standard could be applied in Bradford.
