DUTY TO COOPERATE

I cannot see any information in the files viewed that in depth consultation has taken place between Bradford and Leeds Authorities to agree safeguarding of the green belt or the effect of the two areas merging in terms of manmade development.

Flood issues are a problem in Fulneck and Troydale valley already and top water from the proposed development can only worsen the situation. As a member of a horse-riding group that has to

negotiate a ford across the stream in Fulneck valley I have specific concerns regarding the increase water flows and the health and safety aspects associated with it.

I cannot see any details in the Plan/documents where cooperation with Water Authorities has been carried out or any assessment of risks that increase water flow levels would bring.
