Concern is around the Council's preferred tenure mix, of 70:30 social/affordable rent.

The intermediate Para 5.3.175, has no drafted guidelines on the criteria which would influence the flexibility to the proposed tenure.

Definitely this is needed to ensure local housing demands are met with more certainty than currently the case.

In Burley and Menston house ownership, including those on mortgages, is around 85% while in Bradford as a whole it is 60%.

Residents in Wharfedale will be more inclined to purchase their home, be it on a part equity basis or not, than rent not only because that is the norm in the locality but also because they are more likely to be employed (only 1.6 unemployed compared to Bradford district 5.8% and therefore significantly lower unemployment than the most deprived areas where Affordable Housing is most needed), and also because they benefit from higher wages and better job security than most places in the District.
