In a written statement on 6th March 2014 referring to planning practice guidance, the planning minister Nick Boles re-affirmed green Belt protection, noting that <u>unmet housing need is unlikely to outweigh harm to the green Belt</u> and other harm to constitute very special circumstances justifying inappropriate development

The proposal to build 800 houses in Ilkey will require construction on greenbelt land, as development on that scale is not possible within the town itself.
