Subject: DRAFT CORE STRATEGY - BAILDON

I am informed that the proposals may include the building of approximately 200 houses on West Lane/Lucy Hall Drive in Baildon.

If such a development went ahead, it would result in a dangerous situation along West Lane. The traffic is already very heavy along what has become a major thoroughfare due to other property developments in recent years. The building of 200 houses will mean that a further 400 vehicles will be using this road, which was never designed to take other than a little local traffic, as practically all the residents will access their properties via Baildon village centre. The road passes a primary school, where traffic dangers to young children already abound, has a dangerous bend a little nearer the village centre and then becomes a narrow road passing the doctors' surgery. There is then a further dangerous bend before the road reaches the village centre. This road already takes far more vehicles than it was designed to take and has a continual stream of traffic travelling along it.

Adding significantly to this flow of traffic would be unacceptable and increase further the dangers to which local residents are already exposed, particularly the children who attend the primary school.
