Legal issues

Incompliant Consultation Process - Tong and Holme Wood Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) and Local Development Framework Core Strategy Further Engagement Draft (LDF FED) Public consultation for the NDP and LDF FED are expected to run in parallel. This was not the case, the NDP process finished before the LDF FED.

'Tong and Holme Wood Neighbourhood Development Plan' not formed correctly

The Tong and Holme Wood NDP does not meet the clear requirements of the localism bill framework with means it is not valid. This negates all mention of the Tong and Holme Wood NDP in the Draft Core Strategy.

Soundness

Infrastructure Requirements

Infrastructure requirements of a new community are not discussed, particularly with regard to it's affect on adjoining councils Kirklees and Leeds.

Transport and Traffic Concerns:

There is confusion about the roads proposed to the urban extension. There is conflicting evidence regarding a proposal to build a new highway link road from Westgate Hill to Thornbury. If a proposed link road is built, this would be at the cost of devastating major green belt loss, and serious ecological threat to the important ancient woodland of Black Carr Woods.

Compliancy with 'Duty to co-operate'

Core Strategy does not show how the 'Duty to Co-operate' has been fulfilled

The draft core strategy does not identify how cooperation has been fulfilled – what has been done, any changes made or with whom Bradford Council have co-operated.

Failure to Co-operate with Leeds MC

The greenbelt land under question is used extensively by the population of Leeds City Coucil, however there is no evidence committed and sustained co-operation with Leeds City Council. Objections raised by Leeds City Council have not been addressed or considered.

Failure to co-operate with public bodies.

No evidence of co-operation with health authorities and water companies. A large increase in population will put additional strain on local health care and increased urbanisation will increase flood risk.
