The overwhelming housing need nationally is for starter homes. Consenting the building of new homes in likely and the Wharfe Valley will not satisfy this provision. The houses that will be constructed are likely to be high value homes for affluent middle class people. It is recognised that Bradford must meet its housing target however this should not be translated into a pure numbers exercise. Ilkley and the Wharfe Valley are an easy way to meet the numbers since this is one of few areas within the Bradford district in which sale values and build costs make developments profitable and therefore viable for house builders.

Some areas within the Bradford district will be unviable since sale vales are unlikely to exceed build costs and yet areas such as the town and city centres are where the housing demand is greatest.

Demand for housing in Ilkley is difficult to gauge and even now there are stalled development sites which have failed to be restarted, despite the apparent upturn in the economy and house prices in Ilkley remaining relatively static.

The idea of releasing land from the Green Belt to build high value homes for wealthy people is ludicrous and cannot stand to reason. There will be many brownfield sites within the Bradford district which should be prioritised over Green Belt. The NPPF paras 80, 81 & 82 plus 111 are clear on these points and must be considered.
