Subject: Core Strategy DPD - Proposed Main Modifications

Sir,

Having reviewed the proposed main modifications to the Core Plan, I wish to object to the proposal for the following reasons:-

- No consideration has been given in the Bradford modifications to the additional transport issues arising along the A660 into Leeds as a result of the Leeds plan for development along that route.
- The proposed development, far from improving/maintaining natural animal habitats, will destroy them
- No assessment has been made of the alternative of concentrating on development on the brownfield sites where the majority of issues do not apply
- No adequate infrastructure proposals for schools, parking, transport and other essential amenities have been given in the modification
- The proposals do not address the resulting “merger” of Menston, Burley and Ilkley resulting from the plan.
