I object to the further release of green belt in Bradford 4 and feel it is not justified. The green belt area is small and is one of the very few areas of green land separating Ledds and Bradford. Release of green belt in the Westgate Hill/ Fulneck valley would almost create a continuous conurbation between these tow large cities. The function of green belt is surely to avoid this. Loss of the green belt at the head of the valley and along the steep valley sides would contribute to more frequent and more severe flooding in the lower Aire Valley than has already been experienced. The Fulneck valley was unable to cope with the torrential downpours in December 2015 and led to considerable flooding of Roker Lane, Troydale, and Farnley Beck and Leeds ring road. To remove the upland fields and replace them with tarmac would be catastrophic when any heavy rainfall occurred.

Holmewood is a very deprived urban area with extreme social problems. To remove the green belt

surrounding the Holmewood estate would further harm this community as all access to the recreational facilities offered within the green belt would be removed.

The services of the area in terms of primary health care provision, educational establishments and transport are already overstretched close to breaking point. To release the green belt to build further houses would create chaos within theses already stretched services which currently undertake a sterling job trying to address the huge social problems entrenched in the current Bradford 4 community. This balance is extremely delicate and if further houses are built the current vulnerable/ deprived citizens of Bradford 4 will suffer.

The traffic along Tong Street (A650) is appalling. This is a trunk road into Bradford from the motorway network. To increase the housing along this road will make the entire city of Bradford struggle to move in and out of the city making Bradford isolated further. If transport links are poor and city is disadvantaged for industry and employment opportunities.
