seems to fail to understand the sensitive nature and the impact of what it is proposing.

To justify this new status seems to be based on the premise that these are sustainable settlements because of access to good road and public transport. The present state of infrastructure on road and public transport currently leaves much to be desired. There is no commitment to improve this situation, so the Core Strategy should be viewed as unsound.

Improvements to transport infrastructure is needed but the Council cannot deliver these improvements over the plan period because they rely of other agencies to commit capital expenditure. However, the A65 road, once a trunk road, is at capacity, and it is not possible to increase capacity in the road system without a new primary road. However such a road like that of the Burley Bypass will have a severe visual impact on the character of the valley of Wharfedale. Neither can Bradford Council commit to more capacity on the railway from Ilkley to Leeds/Bradford for similar reasons.

Unless these vital means of transport are improved, the Core Strategy is flawed. You cannot keep loading yet more cars and people onto the creaking road and transport system.

Therefore Bradford Council's overall assessment of it policies as applied to Burley and Menston is ill-considered. There are no grounds for Burley and Menston being elevated to that of Local Growth Centres.
