 MM127 The Group supports the inclusion of all forms of flooding including those associated with ground water in assessing sites for future development. Events during the winter of 2015-16 have clearly shown that numerous sites in Wharfedale identified in the SHLAA are unsuitable for development due to groundwater and other forms of flooding. The Plan and Modifications are unsound since they fail to define, evaluate or justify the combined marginal effects of the combination of current strategy, Sites and current allocations on flood risks, both inside and outside the District.

It is inappropriate for the Wharfe and the Aire valleys for the plan and modifications combined to omit a process to evaluate and understand the combined, marginal effects of the entire development strategy/allocations on the current problems. A comprehensive District-wide flooding study must be undertaken to clearly identify sites, and combinations of sites and allocations, with no marginal flood risks - or combinations which are acceptable with mitigation measures.
