Elevating Burley in Wharfedale, Silsden, Steeton with Eastburn & Menston to Local Growth Centre Status is un-justifiable as it would necessitate unnecessary deletion of greenbelt. The housing numbers proposed in the plan cannot now be justified given that jobs will not be created at the rate originally proposed. (see MM 65). Bradford's housing numbers were predicated on the assumption that nearly 3,000 jobs would be created annually and that this would lead to net inward migration from other parts of the UK. In accepting that net job creation is only likely to be 1600 per annum the Council has accepted that this inward migration will not occur. It follows from this that DCLG/ONS projections on population growth and household formation should apply. This results in a reduction in the need for homes to 30,000 at a maximum (this includes any remediation of under delivery from 2007 onwards . None of the new homes need to be in the greenbelt.
