

Home Support Reviewing Team (HSRT)

The **Home Support Reviewing Team** are a group of professionals responsible for reviewing and monitoring your home support services. The service is designed to help people with disabilities, the elderly, or those recovering from illness or surgery. Our aim is to enable you to live as independently as possible within your own home. We will also, after an assessment of your needs work with you to ensure you have the right support in place.

The **Home Support Reviewing Team** will complete the following:

1. **Assessment of Needs:** The team will complete an assessment using evidence from the care records . You and anyone you wish will be able to fully take part in your assessment. The team will look at your strengths i.e. what you can do and discuss how your support networks may be able to assist with any tasks that you may find difficult. The team may be able to look at equipment needed for you to manage tasks and they can give advice about community support networks that you may be able to use.
2. **Ongoing Support:** Following your assessment any identified tasks that you are unable to manage will be discussed. Your options will be discussed and an appropriate support plan will be put in place.

3. **Reviewing Support Plans:** Based on your assessments, the team may adjust the support plans, either increasing or reducing the level of care or changing services as needed.
4. **Collaboration:** The team work closely with health professionals, social workers, family members, communities, voluntary agencies and home care agencies to ensure comprehensive support and advise is given.

You will be referred to the Home Support Reviewing team by an allocated social care professional should you require a review of your current support.
