Penistone Hill

- Haworth Moor (Open Country)

One of a series of easily accessible countryside sites within the Bradford Metropolitan District.

179 acres (72 hectares) of undulating grass and heather moorland with many rough paths. Situated 1/2 mile to the west of the Bronte village of Haworth.

An ideal 'Walking for Health' site

Due to the very nature of the countryside some areas of the moor may not be suitable for the less mobile and pushchairs. Wheelchair users may find that they are restricted to the roads and car parking areas. There are no gates or stiles on Penistone Hill.

All around Penistone Hill can be found disused quarries. Please take care when walking near these features. No climbing or playing nearby.

Care should also be taken when near the water drainage ponds. Children should be under close supervision at all times.

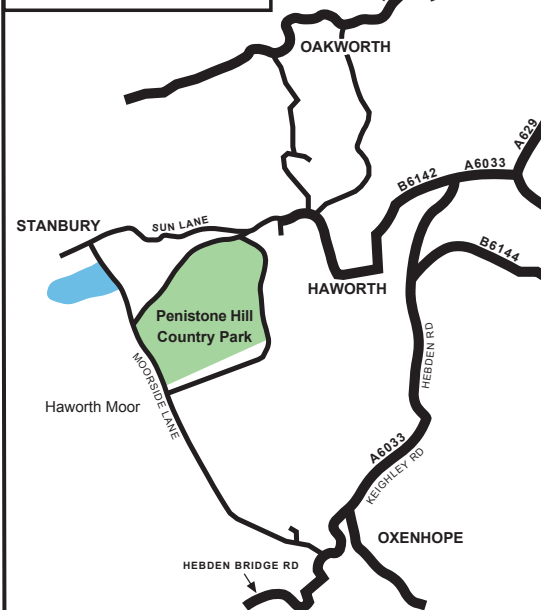
