## Community Infrastructure Levy Regulation 62 Annual Report 2018/2019

## Introduction

- 1.1 The Council began charging the Levy on 1 July 2017. To ensure the Levy is open and transparent, the Council must prepare a short report on the Levy. The report must be published on the Council's website by 31 December each year, for the previous financial year, covering the period 1 April to 31 March. This report covers the period 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2019
- 1.2 .Regulation 62(4) (as amended) sets out what charging authorities must include in their reports. Where a charging authority holds and spends the neighbourhood proportion on behalf of the local community, this should be reported as a separate item. Town and parish councils must also report on their income and spending, and provide a copy of this to Bradford Council.
