The flu vaccination for children is DIFFERENT this year

It is important to boost your child's immunity by getting the safe and free vaccine to protect them, and the rest of your family, from flu.

This year, your child can have:

The nasal spray

- Is quick and painless.
- The best protection against flu.
- Given as a spray squirted up each nostril



The injection

- Is free from any porcine gelatine or animal products
- Better for some children with a long term health condition or allergy



How can I get the vaccination?

Parents of 2 and 3 year-olds should contact their GP for an appointment, as can children in Years 12 and 13 with long term health conditions.

School children up to Year 11 will get their vaccination in school if parents return their consent forms. If you have not returned a signed consent form, please contact the school immunisation team on **01274 221269**.
