Personal information we collect and use

Information collected by us

The information we collect will be the minimum we need to deliver our service and will include the following personal data:

How we use your personal information

We collect your personal information for the following purposes:

- To confirm eligibility for households in relation to the Bradford ECO4 Flexible Eligibility scheme as set out by the energy regulator, the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets (Ofgem)
- To provide information to the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets (OfGem) for audit purposes

How long your personal data will be kept

We will hold your personal information in line with Bradford Council's retention schedule. At its expiry date the information will be reviewed, and only retained where there is an ongoing requirement to retain for a statutory or legal purpose. Following this your personal information will be securely destroyed.

Reasons we can collect and use your personal information

The lawful basis on which we collect and use your personal data is that
