	Saltaire is an outstandingly well preserved example of a mid19th century model industrial textiles town. Saltaire's architectural style design reflects Victorian philanthropic paternalism and its original design, materials and function continue to thrive and express its <u>Outstanding Universal Value</u> .	
	Saltaire aims to be a welcoming and inclusive place with a vibrant community, which takes inspiration from its past, whilst planning for a sustainable future and striking an effective and creative balance between a place to live, invest in, work, learn and visit.	
	Saltaire aspires to be a place where World Heritage significance is fully acknowledged, appreciated and understood by present and future generations. It will strive for the highest standards of interpretation, protection and conservation in support of deliverable economic development and tourism.	
	<ul> <li>b) The UNESCO Sustainable Development Goals were highlighted. This ambitious set of 17 goals was launched after the 2014 Management Plan was adopted. The SDGs need to be incorporated into the new Plan. 	<ul> <li>c) Check 5-6 Themes. It was suggested to incorporate Theme 6 Buffer Zone into the other 5 themes. The 5 remaining themes were classed as the main Objectives or policies.</li> <li>d) Key Delivery partners have been identified in bold to lead on each action, with assistance from other partners identified.</li> <li>e) Actions and overall themes were identified by Steering Group members. Each person identified their first and second priorities by using red and blue dots alongside actions/themes. This resulted in the following priority order; <ol> <li>Protect &amp; conserve</li> <li>Environmental sustainability</li> <li>Economic sustainability/viability</li> <li>The Saltaire community</li> <li>Interpreting &amp; understanding In conclusion the Protection &amp; Enhancement of the WHS take priority over the Promotion of the area.</li> </ol> </li> <li>General discussion on Priorities; Events are key to the vibrancy of the WHS and good links with Shipley to help regenerate the wider area eg events at Northcliffe, Shipley town centre events, Roberts Park, involve Police/Fire, Xmas events, fundraisers for good causes. Historic England encourage the aim to Protect &amp; Conserve WHS and encourage benefits to spread to the Buffer Zone and wider area eg Shipley. It is acknowledged that the approaches to the WHS are shabby in places, although there have been improvements gradually on Saltaire Road over time. The pedestrian experience needs to be enhanced there if possible.</li> </ul>
