You are in receipt of this letter because you have either requested new addressing or requested a change to existing addressing.

The Council has a statutory duty by Law to ensure that all properties are numbered, and streets named under the Town Improvement Clauses Act 1847 Sections 64 and 65, and as such, I now attach a site plan on which the official street name/s and new door number/s or property name/s have been entered. At the bottom of this letter is a table showing the change/s.

Royal Mail, the emergency services, Nottingham Land Registry and a number of other Government and Council Departments have also been informed of this new or changed addressing.

Please Note that it is the developer or the owner that is responsible for ensuring that the postal number/s and/or property/business name/s are clearly displayed to avoid delivery problems and difficulties for emergency services. If your new addressing contains a block of property name in addition to the street name, this will require clear signage, and where a new street is created, the developer will need to provide clear street name plates. Please contact our Highways Department on 01274 437423 for these details where required.

POSTCODE INFORMATION: PLEASE NOTE that the Council do not issue postcodes. Royal Mail have been provided with a copy of this scheme. They have allocated the postcode/s and will reserve the address/es on their 'not yet built' system.

Royal Mail will not display this addressing on their web site, or provide to other companies until the property is occupied or there is a mailbox ready to receive mail deliveries at the new address/es. The Council does not contact Royal Mail on your behalf because this department is not in a position to know when the above has taken place. You will need to do this by contacting Royal Mail as per the paragraph below.

Once through to the agent, ask them to check their not yet built system, and if you are told that they have not received the necessary information from the Council, before ringing us, ensure you make them aware that you are in receipt of a letter from the Council, and quote our reference number (eg 16/99999/S3) found towards the top right hand side of this letter.
